## Turn Your Back UK

The Bournemouth CVS Senior Advisor helped Turn Your Back UK (TYBUK) become the 2<sup>nd</sup> ever Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO) in Bournemouth in 2013. This is a new incorporated legal structure for charities that was introduced at the beginning of January 2013. TYBUK first came to see us in August 2012, with the aim of getting advice on how to set up the charity. They were also given advice on registering with HMRC and helped with governance issues.

TYBUK have since become members of Bournemouth CVS and have made use of all the help on offer.
