Bournemouth Early Help Arrangements



Background & Phase 1

Turnaround is Bournemouth's local delivery of the Government's Troubled Families Initiative. The only payment by results programme in children's services.

Phase 1 (2012 – 2015)

- Children not attending school/excluded
- Adults out of work
- Young People involved in crime/ASB

Target : 370 families 'turned around' against DCLG targets. Success secured entry to phase 2.

Summary of Claims :

- 199 : Crime & Education
- 118 : Crime outcomes
- 33 : Education outcomes
- 20 : Work related outcomes

How we did :

15% of families attached to Turnaround

7% attached to the Partnership

78% captured via data tracking



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Phase 2 : A different approach

Payment by Results potentially offers benefits such as innovative solutions to intractable problems. If it can deliver these benefits, then the increased risk & cost maybe justified, but this requires credible evidence (National Audit Office)

Targets : 123p/a to 278 p/a

Expanded Criteria : (DA, Health & CYP who need help)

Outcomes Plan : sustained/significant progress

Cost Benefit Analysis

To generate robust evidence about what works & informs service transformation.

In the spending review, the Gov't confirmed the commitment to the programme until 2012. Possible new requirements re: school readiness & parenting.



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Arrangements

Progressing the new approach

Between August – December 2015 :

- Identified 1000+ families who meet 2 of the 6 criteria
- 300 Priority Families (cost benefit analysis)
- Shadow Boards
- Aligning TF with EHA

Priority Families : Most complex & high cost outside statutory services

What do we know about these families. Partners are mapping :

- Lead Professionals
- Explicit Consent
- Interventions



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Bournemouth Early Help Arrangements Current Position



Of the 300 priority families, we have identified 211 who have a Lead Professionals. LPs to date are :

- Turnaround/FAST
- YOS/ESW
- Children's Social Care
- Children's Centres
- Health Visitors
- Schools

Our task is to link a lead/key worker to the remaining families. We are asking other teams/services what support they would need to do this.



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Next Steps.....

Engaging & supporting whole families :

- Briefing sessions for LPs
- Assigning additional help : TFEAs, Payment Cards, Spot purchase, Activities
- Monitoring Outcomes – termly progress updates
- Ecins – Assessments & Plans
- Whole family working
- Robust evidence – what makes a sustained difference
